St. Mihiel Offensive of World War I (September 1918) St. Mihiel represented the first large scale massing of airpower under central command. With 1, 500 aircraft, General Mitchell seized the initiative, gained air superiority, attacked ground forces, and interdicted supplies, helping Allied ground forces to achieve their objectives. General Pershing appointed Col (later Brig Gen) William Billy Mitchell as his air com-mander for the battle. Mitchells role was simi-lar to that of a modern joint force air compo-nent commander (JFACC) in that he was both commander of air forces and the chief advisor to the overall commander (in this case General Pershing) on the employment of air assets. Mitchells forces, consisting of airplanes and observation balloons, were the largest massing of airpower the world had yet seen. About 600 of these planes were flown by US personnel.
