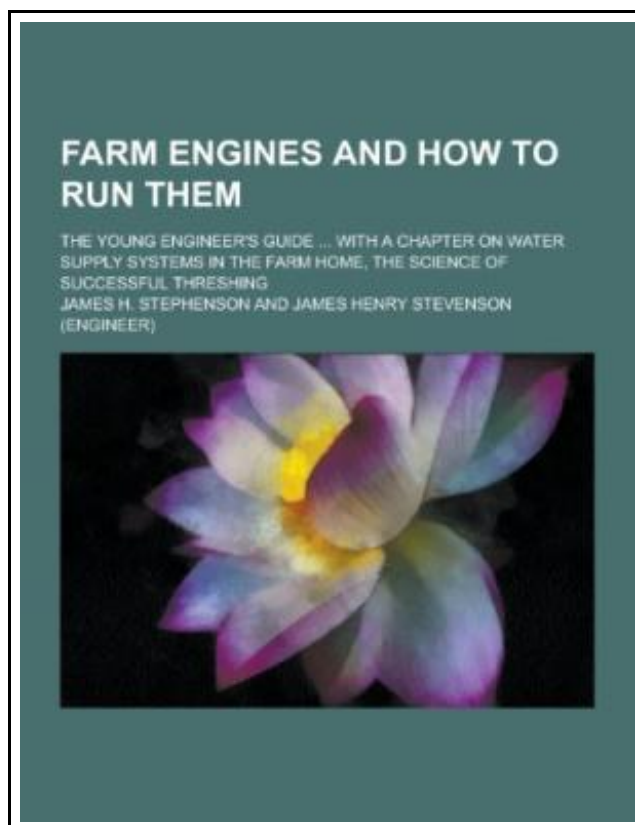

A boiler should be blown off about one gauge at a time two or three times a day with the blow-off if the. water is muddy. Q. How long should the surface blow-off be left open A. Only for a few seconds, and seldom longer than a minute. The surface blow-off carries off the scum that forms on the water, and other impurities that rise with the scum. Q. How do you clean a boiler by blowing off A. When the pressure has been allowed to run down open the blow-off valve at the bottom of the boiler and let the water blow out less than a minute, till the water drops out of sight in the water gauges, or about two and onehalf inches. Blown off more is only a waste of heat and fuel. Q. What harm will be done by blowing off a boiler under a high pressure of steam A. The heat in the boiler while there is such a pressure will be so great that it will bake the scale on the inside of the boiler, and it will be very difficult to remove it afterward. After a boiler has been blown off the scale should be for the most part soft, so that it can be washed out by a...
